## Fraud Alert – Impersonation and Misuse of Servion’s Brand for Fake Recruitment and Business Engagements

It has come to our attention that certain individuals or entities are fraudulently **impersonating Servion Global Solutions executives, HR personnel, and authorized representatives** to carry out deceptive recruitment schemes and fake business proposals. These impersonators misuse Servion’s brand name, identity, and logo—particularly targeting job seekers and small businesses under the guise of employment opportunities or vendor partnerships.

### We wish to categorically state the following:

- **Servion conducts all hiring, business engagements, and partner communications solely through official channels**—our corporate website, verified email domains (e.g., [@servion.com](mailto:@servion.com)), and authorized personnel.
- We **do not authorize any third party** to act on our behalf for recruitment drives, job offers, infrastructure projects, or commercial transactions without a formal agreement and internal validation.
- Reports have emerged that fraudsters are:
  - **Impersonating Servion executives or HR representatives** using fake names, LinkedIn profiles, or email aliases.
  - Sending **fraudulent offer letters, project proposals, or vendor contracts**.
  - Requesting **personal information, registration fees, or deposits** under false pretenses.
  - Operating **unauthorized websites, email addresses, and documents** that mimic Servion branding and visual identity.

These communications and platforms are completely fraudulent. Any commitments made through such impersonations are **not legally binding** and are **not endorsed by Servion in any form**.

### Important Safeguards:

1. **Servion does not charge any fees at any stage** of its recruitment or vendor onboarding process.
2. Any **employment offer or business proposal claiming to be from Servion should be verified** through our official website ([www.servion.com](http://www.servion.com)) or by contacting us directly at [servionhr@servion.com](mailto:servionhr@servion.com).
3. **Do not share personal, financial, or business information** with anyone claiming to represent Servion without proper authentication and verification.
4. **Beware of impersonation attempts** across emails, social media, or messaging platforms. Always cross-check credentials and domains.

We are actively investigating these fraudulent impersonation activities and will pursue appropriate **legal action against any individuals or entities misusing our name, identity, or reputation**.
